Learning Manager's *Due Diligence for Officers* course helps your Officers understand their responsibilities under Model Work Health and Safety legislation.

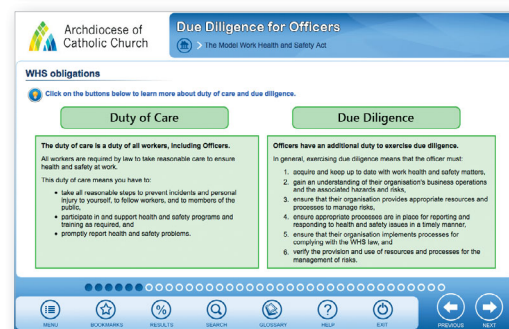
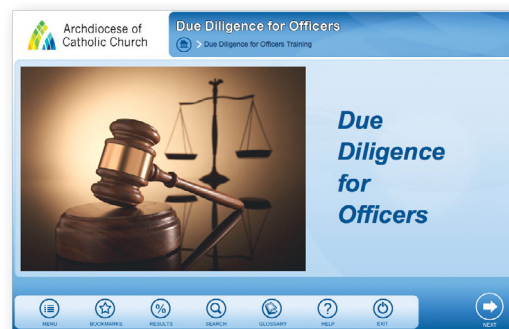
It looks at the differences between general duty of care and the duty to exercise due diligence, which is an additional responsibility of Officers in the workplace.
