### Empower your workers to help protect your information and technology.

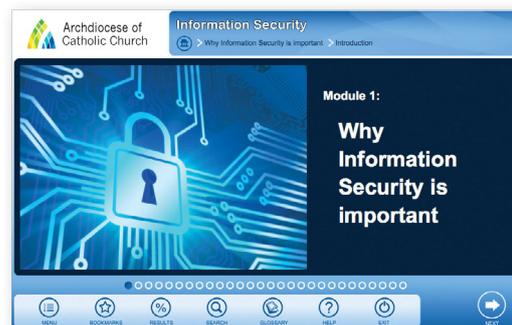
