**A. DETAILS OF APPLICATION**

This application is made under section 411 of the *Corporations Act* 2001 (Cth) (**Corporations Act**) in relation to a proposed scheme of arrangement (**Scheme**) between the plaintiff (**CCI**) and certain of its creditors (**Scheme Creditors**).

**First Court Hearing**

3. Such further or other orders or directions as the Court sees fit.
4. An order that there be liberty to apply.
